FORT EDWARD PAUSE UPDATE

December 4, 2020

Dear Families,

Students in grades K-5 will continue with remote instruction for at least the following days:

Monday, December 7th Tuesday, December 8th Wednesday, December 9th

There is a potential that elementary classes will be required to continue with remote instruction beyond Wednesday, December 9th due to the number of critical staff that are being evaluated for quarantine by the Washington County Department of Public Health contract tracing team. The final determination on the necessity for a longer period of remote only instruction for the elementary grades will be provided to families by Tuesday, December 8th.

Students in grades 6-12 will return to school on Monday, December 7th. Students will return using the same attendance schedule to which they were assigned prior to our December 4th in person pause.

Materials and Devices for the elementary remote learners will be available starting at 8:30am Monday morning. School Principal, Mr. Galarneau is working with the instructional and IT staff to create a schedule for pickups. Please watch for more specific information on the times and protocols for the pick up schedule to be released on our school website and social media accounts soon.

Meal Distribution for the elementary remote learners will be available starting Monday. There will be two pick up times for any students or parents that want or need to access school meals. Meals may be picked up at the Case Street entrance at 11am or 1pm on each of the remote days. I strongly encourage you to take advantage of the free meals, and truly appreciate your understanding as we work through this situation together.
